

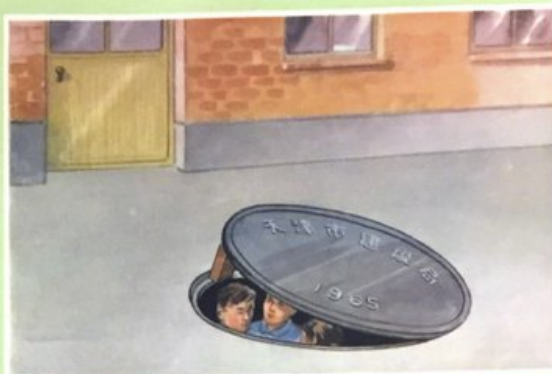

This scene depicts civilians, mainly women and children, evacuating into a tunnel shelter after hearing an air raid alarm. The inscription on the wall reminds them of the importance of keeping discipline: 'Increase discipline, so the Revolution cannot not be won!'
